Several residents from Marco Island have sent us pictures and video of the de-watering activities occurring at Marco Island. At one specific site, intersection of Valley Avenue and Amber Drive, the dewatering activities have been non-stop for about two weeks. As of Friday afternoon (11/30), the de-watering activities were occurring at this location.

We would like to know what actions FDEP will take against Marco Island for the continuing discharge without NPDES permits. EPA is in the process of sending a CWA 308 information request letter to Marco Island to obtain information about their activities. Feel free to contact us if you have any questions.
